Cardinal (or Human) Virtues

Prudence: Prudence, the virtue that compels us to use practical reason to discern, in **every** circumstance, our **true** good and to choose the **right** means for achieving it.

- Justice: Justice, the virtue that compels us to constantly give to God and neighbor their due.
- Fortitude: Fortitude, the virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties AND constancy in the pursuit of the good.
- **Temperance:** Temperance, the virtue that moderates the attraction of the pleasures of the senses and provides balance in the use of created goods.

Theological Virtues

- Faith: By the virtue of Faith, we believe in God and believe all that he has revealed to us and that Holy Church proposes for our belief.
- Hope: By the virtue of Hope we desire, and with steadfast trust, await from God, eternal life AND the graces to merit it.
- **Charity:** By the virtue of charity, we **Love** God above **ALL** things and our neighbor as ourselves for the **Love** of God.
